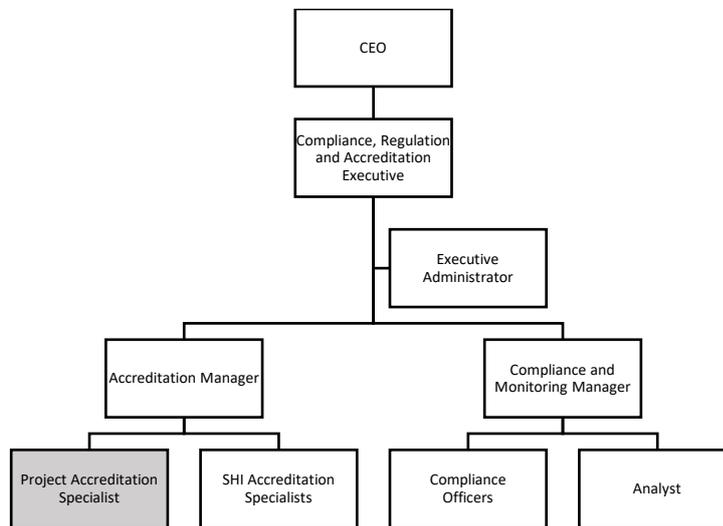
#### Purpose
